Policy # 10: Cell Phones and Pagers

Purpose:

The Screven-Jenkins Regional Library strives to provide services and materials to the public in an environment conducive to their use. Because use of cell phones and pagers in public areas is often disturbing to library users, the Board has adopted this policy.

General Guidelines:

Library visitors are to turn off the ringer or other audible signal of cell phones and pagers (beepers) while in the library.

People making calls on a cell phone must use the vestibule (the area between the inner and outer doors), or go outside to continue their conversations.

People receiving calls on a cell phone must move to the designated areas of the library to continue their conversations.

Signs will be posted notifying the public of this policy.

Responsibility:

Library staff will require that people engaged in cell phone conversations move to the designated area.
